Product Overview	Recombinant Human Serum amyloid A protein was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 13.9 kDa (125aa).

Description	Serum amyloid A1(SAA1) protein is made primarily in the liver and circulates in low levels in the blood. This protein appears to play a role in the immune system. Levels of this protein increase in the blood and other tissues under conditions of inflammation. SAA1 may help repair damaged tissues, acts as an antibacterial agent, and signal the migration of germ-fighting cells to sites of infection. Elevated levels of SAA over time predispose secondary amyloidosis, extracellular accumulation of amyloid fibrils, derived from a circulating precursor, in various tissues and organs. The most common form of amyloidosis occurs secondary to chronic inflammatory disease, particularly rheumatoid arthritis.

Storage	Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
