Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the human RBP7 (NP_443192.1) (Met1-Ala134) was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.
Species	Human

ProteinLength	Met1-Ala134
Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH7.4.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human RBP7 consists of 152 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 17.8 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 19 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 eu per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	>95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	Hardcopy of COA with reconstitution instruction is sent along with the products.
