Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the mouse IL18RAP (NP_034683.1) (Met1-Glu356) was expressed with a C-terminal polyhistidine tag.

Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized mouse IL18RAP-His at 10 µg/ml (100 µl/well) can bind biotinylated mouse IL18, The EC50 of biotinylated mouse IL18 is 10.6-25.0 µg/ml.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant mouse IL18RAP comprises 348 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 40.1 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 44 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 eu per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	>95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C
