Product Overview	Recombinant full-length human AURORAC was expressed by baculovirus in <i>Sf9</i> insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag. MW = 61 kDa.

Description	Aurora C is a member of mitotic serine/threonine kinases that regulate centrosome maturation, chromosome segregation, and cytokinesis. Aurora C has been shown to contribute to oncogenic transformation and is frequently overexpressed and amplified in many human tumors. Aurora C overexpression has been correlated with centrosome amplification, which can be a driving cause of genomic instability in tumor cells. Aurora C is an important regulator of both genomic integrity and cell cycle progression in cancer cells and is an attractive target for anticancer drug development.
Sequence	Full-length.
Applications	Kinase Assay, Western Blot.
Storage And Stability	Store product at -70°C . For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
