Product Overview	The human IL-23 complex composed of the IL23a subunit(NP_057668.1) (Met1-Pro189) and the IL12b subunit(NP_002178.2)(Ile23-Ser328) is fused through a polypeptide linker to the Fc region of mutant human IgG1was expressed in CHO cell.

Description	This gene encodes a subunit of the heterodimeric cytokine interleukin 23 (IL23). IL23 is composed of this proteinand the p40 subunit of interleukin 12 (IL12B). The receptor of IL23 is formed by the beta 1 subunit of IL12(IL12RB1) and an IL23 specific subunit, IL23R. Both IL23 and IL12 can activate the transcription activator STAT4,and stimulate the production of interferon-gamma (IFNG). In contrast to IL12, which acts mainly on naive CD4(+) Tcells, IL23 preferentially acts on memory CD4(+) T cells
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.
