Description	IL15 (interleukin 15) is a protein-coding gene, and is affiliated with the lncRNA class. Diseases associated with IL15 include gamma chain deficiency, and rasmussen encephalitis, and among its related super-pathways are MIF Mediated Glucocorticoid Regulation and Regulation of eIF4 and p70S6K. GO annotations related to this gene include cytokine receptor binding and cytokine activity.
