Product Overview	The extracellular domain of human IL-22RA1 (AAH29273.1)(Pro18-Thr228) is fused to the N-terminus of the Fc region of mouse IgG2a was expressed in CHO cell.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the class II cytokine receptor family, and has been shown to be areceptor for interleukin 22 (IL22). IL22 receptor is a protein complex that consists of this protein andinterleukin 10 receptor, beta (IL10BR/CRFB4), a subunit also shared by the receptor complex for interleukin 10(IL10). This gene and interleukin 28 receptor, alpha (IL28RA) form a cytokine receptor gene cluster in thechromosomal region 1p36.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit IL-22-induced IL-10 secretion by COLO 205 human colorectal adenocarcinoma cells.
