Product Overview	The extracellular domain of human CCL11 (NP_002977.1)(Gly24-Pro97) is fused to the N-terminus of the Fc region of a mutant human IgG1 was expressed in CHO cell.

Description	This gene is one of several chemokine genes clustered on the q-arm of chromosome 17. Chemokines form a superfamily of secreted proteins involved in immunoregulatory and inflammatory processes. The superfamily is divided into four subfamilies based on the arrangement of the N-terminal cysteine residues of the mature peptide. This chemokine, a member of the CC subfamily, displays chemotactic activity for eosinophils, but not mononuclear cells or neutrophils. This eosinophil-specific chemokine is thought to be involved in eosinophilic inflammatory diseases such as atopic dermatitis, allergic rhinitis, asthma and parasitic infections.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to chemoattract BaF3 mouse pro-B cells.
