Product Overview	Recombinant Human MEK2(E55-V400 end) Protein was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Catalyzes the concomitant phosphorylation of a threonine and a tyrosine residue in a Thr-Glu-Tyr sequence located in MAP kinases. Activates the ERK1 and ERK2 MAP kinases. Activates BRAF in a KSR1 or KSR2-dependent manner; by binding to KSR1 or KSR2 releases the inhibitory intramolecular interaction between KSR1 or KSR2 protein kinase and N-terminal domains which promotes KSR1 or KSR2-BRAF dimerization and BRAF activation.

Endotoxin	< 0.01 EU per µg of the protein
Purity	90%
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20 to -80 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -80 centigrade. It is recommended that the

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protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer Supplied as sterile 50mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.5), 200mM NaCl, 20% glycerol

Shipping It is shipped out with blue ice.
