Product Overview	Recombinant Full-length of human FER (1-822(end) amino acids) was expressed as N terminal GST-fusion protein (122 kDa) using baculovirus expression system. GST-FER was purified by using glutathione sepharose chromatography and anion exchange chromatography.

Description	Fer protein is a member of the FPS/FES family of nontransmembrane receptor tyrosine kinases. It regulates cell-cell adhesion and mediates signaling from the cell surface to the cytoskeleton via growth factor receptors.
Purity	94 %. The purity was assessed by SDS-PAGE/CBB staining.
Storage Buffer	50 mM Tris-HCl, 150 mM NaCl, 0.05% Brij35, 1 mM DTT, 10% glycerol, pH7.5.
ATP	100mM.
Substrate	Srctide.
Storage	Store at -80°C. Avoid repeating freeze-thaws.
