Product Overview	The extracellular domain of mouse CD200 (NP_034948.3)(Gln31-Ser236) is fused to the N-terminus of the Fc region of mouse IgG2a was expressed in CHO cell

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a type-1 membrane glycoprotein, which contains two immunoglobulin domains, and thus belongs to the immunoglobulin superfamily. Studies of the related genes in mouse and rat suggest that this gene may regulate myeloid cell activity and delivers an inhibitory signal for the macrophage lineage in diverse tissues. Multiple alternatively spliced transcript variants that encode different isoforms have been found for this gene
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA.
