Description	Phosphorylates proteins on serine, threonine, and tyrosine. Probably associated with cell proliferation. Phosphorylates MAD1L1 to promote mitotic checkpoint signaling. Essential for chromosome alignment by enhancing AURKB activity (via direct CDCA8 phosphorylation) at the centromere, and for the mitotic checkpoint.

Endotoxin	< 0.01 EU per µg of the protein
Purity	90%
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20 to -80 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -80 centigrade. It is recommended that the

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protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer Supplied as sterile 50 mM Tris-HCl (pH7.5), 200 mM NaCl, 20% glycerol

Shipping It is shipped out with blue ice.
