Form	The protein was expressed as 6xHis-tagged fusion protein by E.Coli and purified by Ni-sepharose. The purified protein was resolved in PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH7.4) added with 15% glycerol. The elution buffer contain 300mM imidazole.

Storage	Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C for up to 6 months. Avoid freeze thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of

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0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
