Description	The protein encoded by this gene is expressed on the surface of T cells. It regulates B cell function by engaging CD40 on the B cell surface. A defect in this gene results in an inability to undergo immunoglobulin class switch and is associated with hyper-IgM syndrome.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured in a cell proliferation assay using enriched human B cells in the presence of IL-4.
