SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant human Gremlin-2 is a N-terminus His-tagged protein that was expressed from <i>E. coli</i> . MW = 17.2 kDa.

Source	E.coli
Description	Gremlin (also known as Increased in High Glucose Protein 2, IHG-2, Down-regulated in Mostransformed cells protein, Drm) functions as a bone morphogenetic protein (BMP) antagonist. It acts by binding to, and forming heterodimers with BMP-2, BMP-4, BMP-7, thus preventing them from interacting with their cell surface receptors.
Purity	>95% by SDS-PAGE and HPLC analyses. Endotoxin level is <0.1 ng per µg of Gremlin-2.
Form	Lyophilized with no additives.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the vial prior to opening. Reconstitute to 1 mg/ml with sterilized dH ₂ O. Pipette to dissolve the protein pellet completely.
Storage	The lyophilized protein is best-stored desiccated below 0°C. Reconstituted protein should be stored at working aliquots at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
