Description	PDCD1LG2 (programmed cell death 1 ligand 2) is a protein-coding gene. Diseases associated with PDCD1LG2 include angioimmunoblastic t-cell lymphoma, and oral lichen planus, and among its related super-pathways are Immune System and Phosphorylation of CD3 and TCR zeta chains. GO annotations related to this gene include molecular_function.
