Product Overview	Recombinant human ROR2 (427-end) was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag. MW=86kDa.

Description	ROR2 is a receptor protein tyrosine kinase and type I transmembrane protein that belongs to the ROR subfamily of cell surface receptors. ROR2 is selectively expressed in the chondrocytes of all developing cartilage anlagen, where it is essential during initial growth and patterning, as well as subsequently in the proliferating chondrocytes of mature growth plates, where it is required for normal expansion.

Applications	Kinase Assay, Western Blot.
Storage And Stability	Store product at -70°C. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
