Description	Fibroblast growth factor receptor-1 alpha (FGFR1-alpha) is an isoform of FGFR1 which is a receptor tyrosine kinase. FGFR1-alpha is expressed in prostate luminal epithelial cells. FGFR alpha signals are posteriorizing factors that control node regression and posterior embryonic development.
Molecular Weight	The predicted molecular weight of Recombinant Human FGF R1α (IIIc) is Mr 66 kDa. However, the actual molecular weight as observed by migration on SDS Page is Mr 100-110 kDa.
State Of Matter	Lyophilized.
Purity	> 90% by SDS Page and analyzed by silver stain.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/g as determined by the LAL method.
Storage And Stability	This lyophilized protein is stable for six to twelve months when stored desiccated at -20°C to -70°C. After aseptic reconstitution, this protein may be stored at 2°C to 8°C for one month or at -20°C to -70°C in a manual defrost freezer. Avoid Repeated Freeze Thaw Cycles.
