Product Overview	Biotinylated Recombinant Human BLAME protein(Ala 23-Asp 233), fused with His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in 50 mM Sodium Citrate, 150 mM NaCl, pH5.5. Normally trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human BLAME, His Tag at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Biotinylated Human BLAME, His,Avitag with a linear range of 1-31 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus, followed by an Avi tag (Avitag™).The protein has a calculated MW of 27.1 kDa. The protein migrates as 30-35 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>85% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or

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lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after storage at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
