Bio-activity	Measured in a serum-free cell proliferation assay using MCF-7 human breast cancer cells.The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.2-1 µg/mL.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human Insulin consists of 63 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 7.1 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 6 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Proteinlength	Phe25-Lys53 & Gly90-Asn110
Purity	> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

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Storage Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C
Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
