Product Overview	Biotinylated Recombinant Mouse IL12RB1 protein(Gln20-Ser565), fused with His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Biotinylated Mouse IL-12 R beta 1, His,Avitag at 1 µg/mL (100 µL/well) on streptavidin precoated (0.5 µg/well) plate can bind Human IL-12B, Fc Tag with a linear range of 0.4-13 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus, followed by an Avi tag (Avitag)The protein has a calculated MW of 64.7 kDa. The protein migrates as 93-103 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Proteinlength	Gln20-Ser565
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
