Product Overview	Recombinant Human ITGAM&ITGB2 protein(Phe17-Asn1105(ITGAM)&Gln23-Asn700(ITGB2)), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in 50 mM Tris, 150 mM NaCl, pH7.5. Normally trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	Subunit ITGAM is fused with an acidic tail at the C-terminus and followed by a polyhistidine tag and subunit ITGB2 contains no tag but a basic tail at the C-terminus. The non-reducing (NR) protein migrates as 150-180 kDa (ITGAM) and 85-95 kDa (ITGB2) respectively due to glycosylation.
Proteinlength	Phe17-Asn1105(ITGAM)&Gln23-Asn700(ITGB2)
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at:

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-20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
