Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 14.5 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 25-35 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.

Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE;> 95% as determined by HPLC
Storage	Valid for 12 months from date of receipt when stored at -80°C. Recommend to aliquot

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the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please do not repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

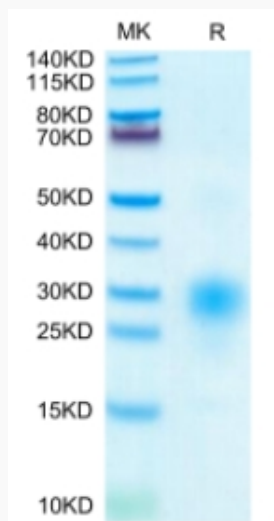

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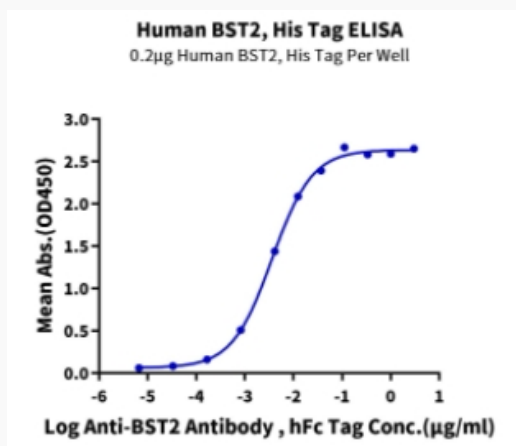
