Product Overview	Recombinant Human ITGAV&ITGB5 protein(Phe 31 - Val 992 (ITGAV) & Gly 24 - Asn 719 (ITGB5)), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in 50 mM Tris, 150 mM NaCl, pH7.5. Normally trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Vitronectin at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Human ITGAV&ITGB5 Heterodimer Protein, His Tag&Tag Free with a linear range of 2-20 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	Human ITGAV&ITGB5 Heterodimer Protein, His Tag&Tag Free, produced by co-expression of ITGAV and ITGB5, has a calculated MW of 112.9 kDa (ITGAV) and 81.9 kDa (ITGB5). Subunit ITGAV is fused with polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus and followed by a acidic tail and subunit ITGB5 contains no tag but a basic tail at the C-terminus. The non-reducing (NR) protein migrates as 130-150 kDa (ITGAV) and 85-95 kDa (ITGB5) respectively due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Reconstitution It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
