Product Overview	Recombinant Human TNFSF15 protein(Met1-Leu192), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human DcR3, Fc Tag at 5 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Human TL1A, His Tag with a linear range of 0.5-15 ng/mL. Immobilized Human TL1A, His Tag at 5 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Human DcR3, Fc Tag with a linear range of 0.1-8 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus. The protein has a calculated MW of 23.7 kDa. The protein migrates as 30 kDa and 31-33 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Proteinlength	Met1-Leu192
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage	Store at -20°C/-80°C upon receipt, aliquoting is necessary for mutiple use. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
