Product Overview	Recombinant Human ECSIT protein(Q9BQ95-1)(Glu246-Ser431), fused with His tag, was expressed in E. coli.

Source	E.coli
ProteinLength	Glu246-Ser431
Form	Lyophilized from sterile 50mM Tris, 10% Glycerol, pH 8.0. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human ECSIT consists of 201 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 22.9 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 25 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
