Storage Buffer

Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered concentrated solution containing 10 mM sodium citrate pH 3.5.

Reconstitution

We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Reconstitute in sterile distilled H₂O to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL.

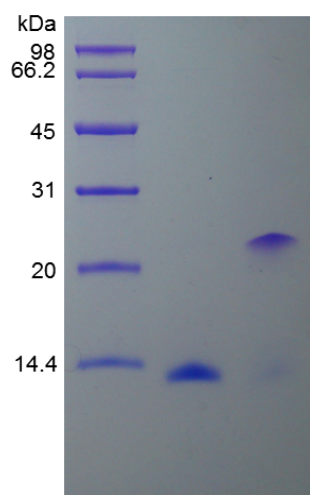
