Description	Catalyzes one of the two ATP producing reactions in the glycolytic pathway via the reversible conversion of 1, 3-diphosphoglycerate to 3-phosphoglycerate. In addition to its role as a glycolytic enzyme, it seems that PGK-1 acts as a polymerase alpha cofactor protein (primer recognition protein). May play a role in sperm motility.

Purity	>90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Notes	For research use only.
Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8 centigrade for one week. Store at -20 to -80 centigrade for twelve months from the date of receipt.
Storage Buffer	Supplied as solution form in PBS pH 7.5 or lyophilized from PBS pH 7.5.

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Reconstitution Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution.

Shipping In general, proteins are provided as lyophilized powder/frozen liquid. They are shipped out with dry ice/blue ice unless customers require otherwise.
