Preparation method	K 562 (Human Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia; Bone Marrow) Cell cytoplasmic Protein Lysate cytoplasmic protein lysate was prepared by isolating the cytoplasmic protein from whole tissue homogenates using a proprietary technique. The cytoplasmic protein is provided in a buffer including HEPES (pH 7.9), MgCl₂, KCl, EDTA, Sucrose, glycerol, and a cocktail of protease inhibitors. For quality control purposes, the isolated K 562 (Human Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia; Bone Marrow) cytoplasmic protein pattern on SDS-PAGE gel is shown to be consistent for each lot by visualization with coomassie blue staining. The isolated K 562 (Human Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia; Bone Marrow) tissue cytoplasmic protein is then Western analyzed by GAPDH antibody, and the expression level is consistent with each lot.

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Storage Buffer	HEPES pH 7.9, MgCl ₂ , KCl, EDTA, Sucrose, Glycerol, Sodium deoxycholate, and NP-40.
Storage Instruction	Store at 2-8°C for continuous use. For extended storage, freeze working aliquots at -70°C. Repeated freezing and thawing is not recommended. Under proper storage conditions the shelf life is half a year from the date of receipt.
Applications	K 562 (Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia; Bone Marrow) Cell Cytoplasmic protein lysate is for use in Western blotting, 10 µg to 20 µg per lane is recommended for mini gel.

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
