SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant COVID-19 protein, His Tag (BA.1/Omicron)(Ser 686 - Pro 1213), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.
Species	Sars-CoV-2

ProteinLength	Ser 686 - Pro 1213
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4. Normally trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized SARS-CoV-2 Spike S2 protein, His Tag (BA.1/Omicron) at 1 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Anti-SARS-CoV-2 Spike S2 protein Antibody, Human IgG4) with a linear range of 0.01-1.6 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus. The protein has a calculated MW of 59.9 kDa. The protein migrates as 70-80 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
