Bio-activity	Anti-NY-ESO-1 antibody captured on CM5 chip via Anti-human IgG Fc antibodies surface can bind Human HLA-A*02:01&B2M&NY-ESO-1 (SLLMWITQV) Tetramer Protein with an affinity constant of 1.15 nM as determined in a SPR assay (Biacore 8K).
Molecular Mass	Human HLA-A*02:01&B2M&NY-ESO-1 (SLLMWITQV) Tetramer Protein is assembled by biotinylated monomer (HL1-H82E4) and streptavidin. Biotinylated Human HLA-A*02:01&B2M&NY-ESO-1 (SLLMWITQV) Complex Protein is produced by co-expression of HLA and B2M loaded with NY-ESO-1 peptide. Biotinylated Human HLA-A*02:01&B2M&NY-ESO-1 (SLLMWITQV) Complex Protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus, followed by an Avi tag (Avitag). The protein has a calculated MW of 36.3 kDa, 13.8 kDa and 13.3 kDa. The protein migrates as 42-45 kDa, 15 kDa and 14 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to

Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE. >90% as determined by SEC-MALS.
Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
