Product Overview	Biotinylated Recombinant COVID-19 Protein, His,Avitag (BA.4 & BA.5/Omicron)(Ser 13 - Leu 303), fused with His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Biotinylated SARS-CoV-2 Spike NTD, His,Avitag (BA.4 & BA.5/Omicron) at 1 µg/mL (100 µL/well) on streptavidin precoated (0.5 µg/well) plate can bind Anti-SARS-CoV-2 Spike NTD Antibody, Chimeric mAb, Human IgG1 with a linear range of 0.1-2 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus, followed by an Avi tag (Avitag)The protein has a calculated MW of 34.4 kDa. The protein migrates as 55-66 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE. >90% as determined by SEC-MALS.

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Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
