SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse FasL Protein (Gln128-Leu279) with N-His tag was expressed in E. coli and Animal-free as well as Carrier-free.

ProteinLength	Gln128-Leu279
Description	Fas Ligand (FasL) is a 17.34 kDa tumor necrosis factor with 152 amino acid residues. FasL is mainly expressed from lymphoid tissue and secreted to blood. Binding to its receptor, TNFRSF6/FAS, leads to induce apoptotic signal into cells. Involved in cytotoxic T-cell-mediated apoptosis, natural killer cell-mediated apoptosis and in T-cell development.
Form	Lyophilized
Bio-activity	Measure by its ability to induce apoptosis in Jurkat cells. The ED50 for this effect is < 1 µg /mL.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 18.27 kDa. The protein migrates as 17-25 kDa under reducing condition (SDS-PAGE analysis).
Endotoxin	< 0.1 EU/µg of the protein by the LAL method.

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Purity	>98% as determined by SDS-PAGE analysis.
Storage	This product is stable after storage at: -20 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state from date of receipt. -20 or -80 centigrade for 1 month under sterile conditions after reconstitution. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of PBS, pH 8.0.
Reconstitution	It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile H2O to a concentration not less than 200 µg/mL and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min to ensure sufficient re-dissolved.
Shipping	The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at -20 centigrade or lower for long term storage.

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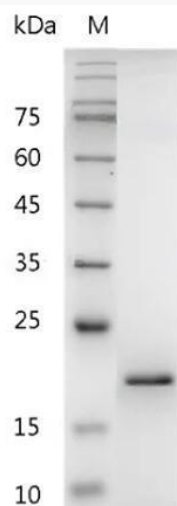
