Product Overview	Recombinant human RhoC protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 23.8 kDa (210aa).

Description	RhoC, also known as rho-related GTP-binding protein RhoC, is a small signaling G protein (more specifically a GTPase), and is a member of the Rac subfamily of the family Rho family of GTPases. It cycles between inactive GDP-bound and active GTP-bound states and function as molecular switches in signal transduction cascades. RhoC promotes reorganization of the actin cytoskeleton and regulate cell shape, attachment, and motility.
Form	Liquid. 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH8.0) containing 20% glycerol 0.1M NaCl, 1mM DTT.
Purity	> 90% by SDS - PAGE.
Concentration	0.5 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).

Storage	Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.

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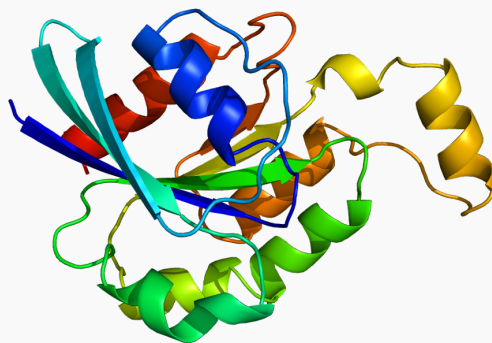
