Product Overview	Recombinant Human TIGIT (Q495A1-1) (Met1-Pro141) was expressed in HEK293 with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human TIGIT His at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Human CD155/PVR hFc, the EC50 is 20-240 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human TIGIT consists of 131 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 14.5 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 19.7 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.>90% as determined by SEC-HPLC
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C.

Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
