Product Overview	Recombinant human PRTN3 protein without tag was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Serine protease that degrades elastin, fibronectin, laminin, vitronectin, and collagen types I, III, and IV (in vitro). By cleaving and activating receptor F2RL1/PAR-2, enhances endothelial cell barrier function and thus vascular integrity during neutrophil transendothelial migration. May play a role in neutrophil transendothelial migration, probably when associated with CD177.
Form	Lyophilized powder/frozen liquid
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Notes	For research use only.
Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8 centigrade for one week. Store at -20 to -80 centigrade for twelve months from the date of receipt.
Storage Buffer	Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH 7.5 or lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.5.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution.

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Shipping They are shipped out with dry ice/blue ice unless customers require otherwise.
