Product Overview	Recombinant Rat PCSK9 (NP_954862.2) (Met 1-Gln 691) was expressed in HEK293, fused with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	1. Measured by its ability to bind biotinylated Human LDLR in a functional ELISA. 2. Measured by its ability to bind biotinylated Mouse LDLR in a functional ELISA.
Molecular Mass	The secreted recombinant pro form of Rat PCSK9 comprises 672 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 72.8 kDa. As a result of glycosylation and proteolytic digestion, Rat PCSK9 migrates as doublet with apparent molecular mass of 20 kDa and 62 kDa corresponding to the pro domain and mature form respectively in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Purity	> 97 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
