Product Overview	Recombinant Human EPOR (NP_000112.1)(Met 1-Pro 250) linked with the extracellular domain (Trp 17-Trp 443) of Human CD131 (NP_000386.1) by a peptide linker was expressed in HEK293, fused with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	1. Measured by its ability to bind Rat EPO-His in a functional ELISA. 2. Measured by its ability to bind Mouse EPO-His in a functional ELISA.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant heterodimer of Human EPOR & CD131 comprises 906 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 101 kDa.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

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Storage Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
