Product Overview	Recombinant Human SPINK1 Protein, fused to His and Met-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a trypsin inhibitor, which is secreted from pancreatic acinar cells into pancreatic juice. It is thought to function in the prevention of trypsin-catalyzed premature activation of zymogens within the pancreas and the pancreatic duct. Mutations in this gene are associated with hereditary pancreatitis and tropical calcific pancreatitis.
Form	Supplied as a 0.2 µm filtered solution in MES, NaCl, CaCl ₂ , DTT, Glycerol and Brij-35.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit trypsin cleavage of a fluorogenic peptide substrate, Mca-RPKPVE-Nval-WRK(Dnp)-NH ₂ . The IC ₅₀ value is <10 nM, as measured under the described conditions.
Molecular Mass	Predicted Molecular Mass: 7 kDa SDS-PAGE: 8-11 kDa, reducing conditions

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Endotoxin	<1.0 EU per 1 µg of the protein by the LAL method.
Purity	>85%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by Colloidal Coomassie® Blue stain at 5 µg per lane.
Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 6 months from date of receipt, -70 centigrade as supplied. 3 months, -70 centigrade under sterile conditions after opening.
Shipping	The product is shipped with dry ice or equivalent. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended below.
