Product Overview	Biotinylated Recombinant Influenza A virus (A/Puerto Rico/8/34/Mount Sinai (H1N1)) nucleoprotein (AAM75159.1, with mutation Ile 116 Met) (Met1-Gly490) was expressed in Insect Cells, fused with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant Influenza A virus (A/Puerto Rico/8/34/Mount Sinai (H1N1)) nucleoprotein comprises 501 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 56.7 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 54.4 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
