Description	Luteinizing hormone (LH) is a glycoprotein hormone that is co-secreted along with follicle-stimulating hormone by the gonadotrophin cells in the adenohypophysis (anterior pituitary). Luteinizing hormone is a part of a neurological pathway comprised of the hypothalamus, the pituitary gland, and gonads.

Storage	On arrival, store refrigerated at 2 centigrade to 8 centigrade short term (up to 2 weeks) or frozen below -15 centigrade. After reconstituting, store frozen in small

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aliquots. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer Lyophilized from 50 mM ammonium bicarbonate.
