Product Overview	Recombinant SARS-CoV-2 (B.1.1.529 sublineage BA.2) Nucleocapsid (YP_009724397.2, with mutations P13L, ERS31-33 del, R203K, G204R, S413R) (Met1-Ala419) was expressed in E. coli with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus. The mutations were identified in the SARS-CoV-2 variant (known as variant B.1.1.529 sublineage BA.2).

Form	Lyophilized from sterile 50mM PB, 500mM NaCl, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant SARS-CoV-2 (B.1.1.529 sublineage BA.2) Nucleocapsid consists of 423 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 46.38 kDa.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
