Product Overview	Recombinant Human HLA-A&B2M protein(AAV53343.1(HLA-A*11:01)&P61769(B2M)&VVVGAGGVGK)(Gly25-Thr305(HLA-A*11:01),Ile21-Met119(B2M)and VVGAGGVGK peptide), fused with C-terminal His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

ProteinLength	Gly25-Thr305(HLA-A*11:01),Ile21-Met119(B2M)and VVGAGGVGK peptide
Form	Supplied as 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4).
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 50.30 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 55-60 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE
Storage	Valid for 12 months from date of receipt when stored at -80°C.;Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please do not repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of

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0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

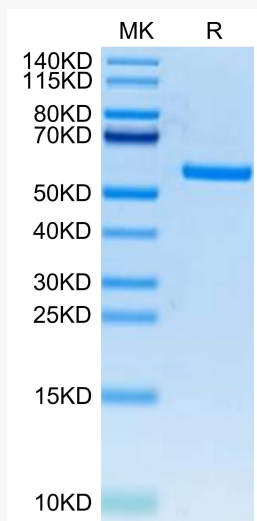

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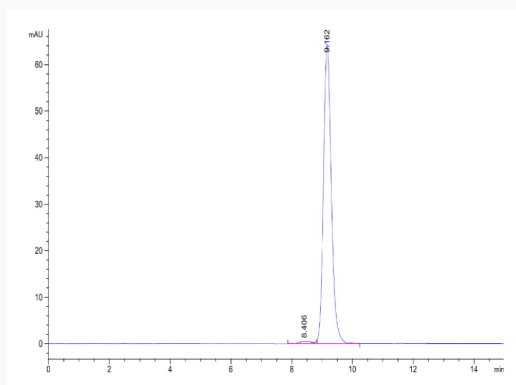
