Description	Interleukin 11 receptor alpha (IL11RA) is a subunit of the interleukin 11 receptor that is expressed in hematopoietic and other organs. IL11RA is a functional target in bone metastasis and is considered as a candidate target in human osteosarcoma and provide leads for the development of novel imaging and therapeutic agents for the management of this malignant tumor.
Molecular Weight	The predicted molecular weight of Recombinant Mouse IL-11 R α is Mr 65 kDa. However, the actual molecular weight as observed by migration on SDS Page is Mr 70-80 kDa.
State Of Matter	Lyophilized.
Purity	>97% by SDS Page and analyzed by silver stain.
Endotoxin	<0.1 ng per 1 g as determined by the LAL method.
Storage And Stability	This lyophilized protein is stable for six to twelve months when stored desiccated at -20°C to -70°C. After aseptic reconstitution, this protein may be stored at 2°C to 8°C for one month or at -20°C to -70°C in a manual defrost freezer. Avoid Repeated Freeze
