

Recombinant allergen Mal d 3 for Malus domestica (Apple)

SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Mal d 3 isoform 3.01 is a non-specific lipid transfer protein type 1 (nsLTP1) and is an allergen of the apple (order Rosales). It has been prepared as a recombinant mature allergen fused to a his-tag in its N-terminus.
Source	E.coli
Molecular Mass	Determined by SDS-PAGE, the protein band is between the molecular markers of 18, 400 and 14, 400 Da, while relative molecular mass calculated from amino acid sequence is 17, 666.75 Da.
Purity	>95% in a SDS-PAGE
Incidence	Not tested. According to the bibliography, the incidence of the protein is 31%
IVD	Serodiagnosis of allergy to Apple
Stability	The protein will remain stable for four years if stored frozen.
Observation	Proteins should be maintained frozen at high concentrations. In order to defrost the protein, maintain the aliquot at 25°C without shaking to avoid aggregation. Prior making test dilutions and after defrosting the protein, is recommended to remove possible protein aggregates by centrifuging the stock solution, avoiding alterations in the immobilization of the biomolecule to the solid surface.
Storage	Protein is shipped with dry ice. Upon arrival, it should be aliquoted in order to avoid

repeated freezing and thawing cycles and stored at -20°C to -80°C.

Notes

During shipment, small volumes of product will occasionally become entrapped in the seal of the product vial. For products with volumes of 200 ul or less, we recommend gently tapping the vial on a hard surface or briefly centrifuging the vial in a tabletop centrifuge to dislodge any liquid in the containers cap.

Although recombinant antigens are expressed in non-pathogenic *P.pastori* and bacterial integrity is destroyed during purification, the antigen preparation should be handled as potentially infectious.
