Product Overview	Recombinant human RAB35 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli and purified by using conventional chromatography. MW: 25.2 kDa.

Description	RAB35 is localized to the plasma membrane and endocytic compartments and controls a fast endocytic recycling pathway. Consistent with a key requirement for Rab35-regulated recycling during cell division, inhibition of Rab35 function leads to the accumulation of endocytic markers on numerous cytoplasmic vacuoles in cells that failed cytokinesis.
Form	Liquid. 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH8.0) containing 40% glycerol, 0.15M NaCl, 1mM DTT.
