Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the mouse GPC3 (Met1-Pro558) was expressed with a C-terminal polyhistidine tag.

Source	Insect Cells
Description	lypican-3 is a protein that in humans is encoded by the GPC3 gene. The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the glypican family.
Predicted N Terminal	Gln 25
Form	Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, 10% glycerol, pH 7.4.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant mouse GPC3 comprises 544 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 62 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 33-37 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
Purity	> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
