Product Overview	Recombinant Human CCL25(Gln24-Leu150) fused with the N-terminus of the Fc region of human IgG1 was expressed in CHO.

Description	This antimicrobial gene belongs to the subfamily of small cytokine CC genes. Cytokines are a family of secreted proteins involved in immunoregulatory and inflammatory processes. The CC cytokines are proteins characterized by two adjacent cysteines. The cytokine encoded by this gene displays chemotactic activity for dendritic cells, thymocytes, and activated macrophages but is inactive on peripheral blood lymphocytes and neutrophils. The product of this gene binds to chemokine receptor CCR9. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to chemoattract BaF3 mouse pro-B cells.
Molecular Mass	40KDa (monomer)
Endotoxin	<0.1 EU/µg as determined by LAL test.

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Purity	>98%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Storage	Stable for at least 1 year after receipt when stored at -20 centigrade. Working aliquots are stable for up to 3 months when stored at -20 centigrade. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute at 100µg/ml in sterile PBS.
