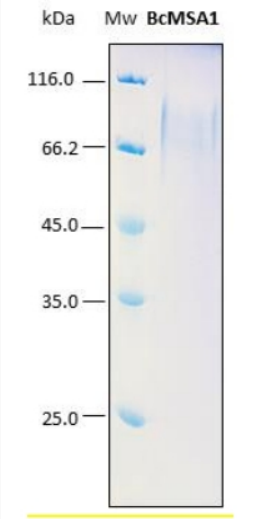

Product Overview	Recombinant antigen formed by the fragment containing a 1 to 303 of BcMSA1 for <i>B. canis</i> and fused to a His-tag in its C-terminus and monobiotinylated in vivo.

Description	Merozoite surface antigen (BcMSA1) was described as a potential candidate for babesiosis serodiagnosis, evaluated by ELISA.

Molecular Mass	SDS-PAGE analysis determines that the protein band is between the molecular markers of 116 kDa and 66.2 kDa due to the glycosylation pattern, while relative molecular mass, calculated from amino acid sequence and without glycosylation, is 43,031.64 Da.
Purity	> 95% by observation on SDS-PAGE electrophoresis

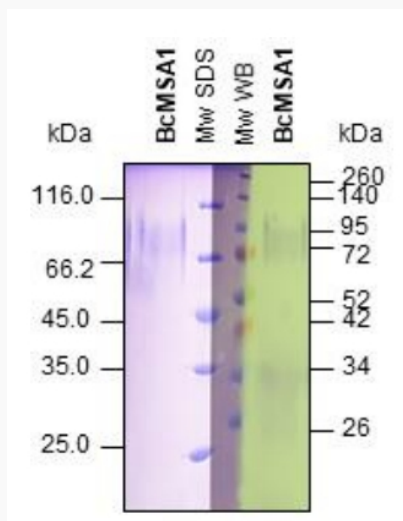
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Storage	Upon arrival, it should be aliquoted to avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles and stored at -20 to -80 centigrade. In order to defrost the protein, maintain the aliquot at 25 centigrade without shaking to avoid aggregation.
Storage Buffer	20 mM phosphate buffer pH 8 and 0.15 M NaCl
Concentration	1.11 mg/mL
Shipping	Protein is shipped with dry ice.
