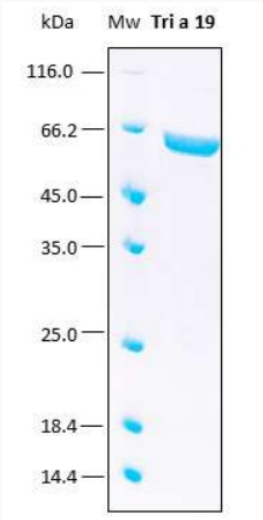

Product Overview	Tri a 19 or omega-5 gliadin, the major allergen of wheat, has been prepared as a recombinant mature allergen fused to a his-tag.

Description	Tri a 19, or omega-5 gliadin, the major allergen of wheat, has been prepared as a recombinant mature allergen fused to a his-tag.

Molecular Mass	Determined by SDS-PAGE, the protein band is at the molecular marker of 66.2 kDa, while relative molecular mass calculated from amino acid sequence is 59,872.54 Da.
Endotoxin	< 0.1 EU/mL
Purity	> 95% by observation on SDS-PAGE electrophoresis
Applications	WB, DB, IE, DE
Storage	Upon arrival, it should be aliquoted to avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles and stored at -20 to -80 centigrade. In order to defrost the protein, maintain the aliquot at 25 centigrade without shaking to avoid aggregation.

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Storage Buffer	20 mM phosphate buffer pH 6, 0.15 M NaCl, 0.13 M trehalose, 0.1% polyoxyethylene (10) tridecyl ether and 2 M urea
Concentration	1.03 mg/mL
Shipping	Protein is shipped with dry ice.
